

Bayside Centre is easily accessible with plenty of onsite and street parking, and only a 30-minute drive from Brisbane (UBD Map 185 Ref P18). Alternatively, it is easily reached by both bus and train. There is a bus stop virtually at the door and the Cleveland railway station is a flat pleasant walk through Raby Bay Harbour precinct and the central business area.

THIRTY dealers and fresh stock

Bayside Antique & Collectables Centre's 30 rofessional dealers offer a wonderful range of antiques, collectables and old wares. There is a good selection of quality English and Australian furniture from the late 1800s through to the 1950s in a variety of timbers such as silky oak, English oak, cedar, maple, mahogany and pine. Collectables include china, glassware, silver, pottery, linen, arts, antique and estate jewellery, toys, shabby chic and retro.

The Centre is continually developing specialised areas and making improvements to suit our customers. The militaria area is taking shape with quite a number of very interesting items for sale. For numismatic and philatelic collectors there is a section devoted to coins, banknotes and stamps. The 'book nook' stocks adult and children's fiction and non-fiction,

reference books and many other topics. It also includes a range of vinyl records and sheet music.

Photographic collectables and our dedicated 'tool room' are proving popular with collectors. While once seen as the domains of men, there are quite a number of women who are avid collectors of photographic items and tools. The outdoor area is now open for architectural, garden furniture and related items, with many more refinements planned.

The Bayside Centre mezzanine is dedicated to fashion, complete with a proper change room. Here are women's and men's clothing, shoes, hats, handbags and other accessories. Many of the Centre's dealers contribute fashions to this floor, guaranteeing a changing stock from vintage to retro, pre-loved and labels. Prices are very reasonable - it's a great place for a rummage.
